WHEREAS, an electrical malfunction occurred at the Oak Cliff Municipal Center located at 320 East Jefferson Boulevard which caused smoke damage to the facility; and

**WHEREAS,** Texas Government Code Section 252.022 (a)(3), exempts procurements necessary because of unforeseen damage to public machinery, equipment, or other property from the standard purchasing procedures; and

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary to ratify a service contract with Dalworth Restoration, Inc. for emergency restoration services at the Oak Cliff Municipal Center located at 320 East Jefferson Boulevard, in an amount not to exceed \$471,290.71.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to ratify a service contract with Dalworth Restoration, Inc. for emergency restoration services provided at the Oak Cliff Municipal Center located at 320 East Jefferson Boulevard, in an amount not to exceed \$471,290.71.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$471,290.71 to Dalworth Restoration, Inc. from Capital Construction Fund, Fund 0671, Department BSD, Unit W506, Object 3210, Activity EB01, Program BS20029, Encumbrance/Contract No. BSD-2020-00014215, Commodity 91024, Vendor VS000000115.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas and it is accordingly so resolved.
