An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 28895, passed by the Dallas City Council on January 23, 2013, which amended the zoning ordinances of the City of Dallas, and granted Specific Use Permit No. 2006 for an attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign; amending the conditions in Section 2 of that ordinance; providing a penalty not to exceed \$2,000; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the city plan commission and the city council, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Dallas, the state law, and the ordinances of the City of Dallas, have given the required notices and have held the required public hearings regarding this amendment to Specific Use Permit No. 2006; and

WHEREAS, the city council finds that it is in the public interest to amend Specific Use Permit No. 2006; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS: SECTION 1. That the conditions in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 28895 are amended to read as follows:

- "1. <u>USE</u>: The only use authorized by this specific use permit is an attached projecting non-premise district activity videoboard sign.
- 2. <u>SITE PLAN</u>: Use and development of the Property must comply with the attached site plan and elevation.
- TIME LIMIT: This specific use permit expires [automatically terminates] on April 10, 2022 [January 23, 2019].
- 4. <u>MAINTENANCE</u>: The Property must be properly maintained in a state of good repair and neat appearance.


SECTION 2. That a person who violates a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.


