WHEREAS, the City of Dallas owns and operates a 48-inch water transmission pipeline that provides treated water to several customers, including Irving and the Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and the City of Irving have mutually determined that a section of 48-inch water transmission pipeline within the City of Irving should be relocated in the best interest of City of Dallas and City of Irving customers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas Water Utilities Department has completed engineering designs for the relocation of the water transmission pipeline within the City of Irving's public right-of-way along Ranchview Drive and Ranch Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and City of Irving desire to enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the relocation of the water transmission pipeline, including project management responsibilities, project cost allocations, right-of-way provisions for protection of the pipeline, and communication requirements for future operation and maintenance of the pipeline; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2020, seven bids were received for the installation of 48-inch and 30-inch diameter water transmission pipelines along Ranchview Drive and Ranch Trail in the City of Irving, Contract No. 20-231, listed as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Ark Contracting Services, LLC, 420 South Dick Price Road, Kennedale, Texas 76060, in the amount of \$3,010,639.00, is the lowest and best of all bids received.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the bid submitted by Ark Contracting Services, LLC, in the amount of \$3,010,639.00, for doing the work covered by the plans, specifications, and contract documents, Contract No. 20-231, be accepted.

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SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with Ark Contracting Services, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the relocation of a 48-inch diameter water transmission pipeline along Ranchview Drive and Ranch Trail in the City of Irving, in an amount not to exceed \$3,010,639.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,010,639.00 to Ark Contracting Services, LLC, as follows:

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
