WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and the City of Irving have mutually determined that a section of 48-inch water transmission pipeline within the City of Irving should be relocated in the interest of both City of Dallas and City of Irving customers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas Water Utilities Department has completed engineering designs for the relocation of the water transmission pipeline within the public right-of-way along Ranchview Drive and Ranch Trail within the corporate limits of Irving; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and City of Irving desire to enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the relocation of the water transmission pipeline, including project management responsibilities, project cost allocations, right-of-way provisions for protection of the pipeline, and communication requirements for future operation and maintenance of the pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and the City of Irving believe this agreement is in the best interest of both parties.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Dallas and the City of Irving, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the relocation of a 48-inch water line within Irving Corporate limits, in an amount not to exceed \$1,160,447.28.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,113,936.43 in Water Construction Fund, Fund 0102, Department DWU, Balance Sheet Account 0519.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$46,510.85 in Dallas Water Utilities Fund, Fund 0100, Department DWU, Unit 7005, Revenue Code 7505.

SECTION 4. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DWU-2020-00014316.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
