WHEREAS, on April 22, 2020, City Council authorized the acceptance of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, Coronavirus Relief Funds to aid the COVID-19 response throughout the City by Resolution No. 20-0644; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2020, City Council was briefed on the proposed uses of Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act, Coronavirus Relief Funds to facilitate assistance to eligible communities and households economically impacted by COVID-19.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute three separate cooperative purchasing agreements for the purchase and installation of hardware, licenses, maintenance, and support of various network elements that together comprise a multi-level network security and monitoring solution in response to COVID-19 work from home efforts for the Department of Information and Technology Services with Future Com Ltd. (507022) through The Interlocal Purchasing System cooperative agreement for the IXIA Enterprise system and Nozomi system in the combined amount of \$1,020,484.96 and Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC (VC19333) through the Department of Information Resources cooperative agreement for the NetScout system in the amount of \$556,282.41, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of three years, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,576,767.37. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments to Future Com, Ltd. and Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Future Com, Ltd. and Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,576,767.37 to Future Com, Ltd. and Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract Nos. DSV-2020-00014278, DSV-2020-00014280, and DSV-2020-00014279.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
