WHEREAS, on May 11, 2016, City Council authorized a three-year professional services contract, with two one-year renewal options, for independent medical review services with ExamWorks, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, by Resolution No. 16-0714; and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-5939 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the professional services contract with ExamWorks, Inc. to extend the term of the contract for one year from May 11, 2019 through May 10, 2020, with zero cost, having no cost effect on the contract amount.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Trinity Review Services, Inc. (VS0000074733), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for professional independent medical review services for the City Attorney's Office for a term of three years, with two one-year renewal options, in the estimated amount of \$105,000. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Trinity Review Services, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Trinity Review Services, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$105,000, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Trinity Review Services, Inc. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. CAO-2020-00012542.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
