**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2019, City Council authorized a one-year service contract with two one-year renewal options for the Overcoming Barriers to Work Program with (1) Open Arms, Inc. dba Bryan's House in the amount of \$\$36,698.00, (2) International Rescue Committee, Inc. in the amount of \$76,833.00), and (3) The Salvation Army in the amount of \$40,337.00 by Resolution No. 19-1657; and

**WHEREAS**, participants in the Digital Literacy for Work Project will be able to gain the foundational digital literacy skills they need to succeed in job training and career development programs, that lead to either a first job or a higher skill, higher paying wage job.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the first of two, one-year renewal options to the service contract with International Rescue Committee, Inc., approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide digital literacy skills for work to limited English proficient low- to moderate-income residents of Dallas through the Overcoming Barriers to Work Program for the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$76,833.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$76,833.00 to International Rescue Committee, Inc. from the 2020-21 Community Development Block Grant Fund, Fund CD20, Department MGT, Unit 470E, Object 3070, Encumbrance/Contract No. OCC-2019-00011511, Vendor VS100372.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
