WHEREAS, on October 23, 2019, City Council authorized a one-year service contract with two one-year renewal options for the Overcoming Barriers to Work Program with (1) Open Arms, Inc. dba Bryan's House in the amount of \$36,698.00, (2) International Rescue Committee, Inc. in the amount of \$76,833.00, and (3) The Salvation Army in the amount of \$40,337.00, by Resolution No. 19-1657; and

WHEREAS, single mothers participating in the Single Working Mothers Program will be provided specialized childcare for their special needs children at no cost.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the first of two, one-year renewal options to the service contract with Open Arms, Inc. dba Bryan's House, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide single mothers with specialized childcare for their special needs children through the Overcoming Barriers to Work Program for the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$36,698.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$36,698.00 to Open Arms, Inc. dba Bryan's House from the 2020-21 Community Development Block Grant Fund, Fund CD20, Department MGT, Unit 468E, Object 3070, Encumbrance/Contract No. OCC-2019-00011509, Vendor 266376.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
