WHEREAS, on October 23, 2019, City Council authorized a one-year service contract with two one-year renewal options for the Overcoming Barriers to Work Program with (1) Open Arms, Inc. dba Bryan's House in the amount of \$36,698.00, (2) International Rescue Committee, Inc. in the amount of \$76,833.00, and (3) The Salvation Army A Georgia Corporation in the amount of \$40,337.00, by Resolution No. 19-1657.

**WHEREAS**, participants in the Carr P. Collins Social Service Center will be provided prevention and recovery programs that are designed to assist those in varying stages of crisis by providing low barrier access to food, shelter, and supportive services to help end their crisis and begin a path to recovery.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the first of two, one-year renewal options to the service contract with The Salvation Army A Georgia Corporation, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide services to individuals and families overcoming homelessness, addiction and poverty through the Overcoming Barriers to Work Program for the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$40,337.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$40,337.00 to The Salvation Army A Georgia Corporation from the 2020-21 Community Development Block Grant, Fund CD20, Department MGT, Unit 469E, Object 3070, Encumbrance/Contract No. OCC-2019-00011511, Vendor VC0000007928.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
