WHEREAS, on June 7, 2018, Administrative Action No. 18-6012 authorized continued support of the City's workstation used to access the National Integrated Ballistic Information Network administered by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives for the Police Department with Ultra Electronics Forensic Technology, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$34,843.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Ultra Electronics Forensic Technology, Inc. (VS0000069335), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for maintenance and support of an integrated ballistic identification system for the Police Department for a term of five years, in an amount not to exceed \$81,200. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments to Ultra Electronics Forensic Technology, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Ultra Electronics Forensic Technology, Inc. under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$81,200 (subject to annual appropriations) to Ultra Electronics Forensic Technology, Inc. from Service Contract No. DSV-2020-00013897.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
