**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2, Article X of the Dallas City Code establishes a Public Art Program to include works of art and design services of artists in certain City capital improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, in carrying out the intent of the Public Art Program, the Office of Arts and Culture, working with the Public Art Committee, has identified a public art project to complement the Fire Station No.36 located at 2300 Singleton Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, Michael Pavlovsky DBS Pavlovsky Sculpture Studio, LLC was selected for the project and was approved by the Public Art Committee and the Arts and Culture Advisory Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, \$62,000.00 is now currently available from the Public Safety (G) Fund to support the fabrication and installation of a site-specific artwork at 2300 Singleton Boulevard.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Michael Pavlovsky DBA Pavlovsky Sculpture Studio, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to fabricate and install a site-specific artwork at Fire Station No. 36 located at 2300 Singleton Boulevard, in an amount not to exceed \$62,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$62,000.00 to Michael Pavlovsky DBA Pavlovsky Sculpture Studio, LLC from Public Safety (G) Fund, Fund 1V33, Department BSD, Unit PA62, Object 4425, Program EB17PA62, Encumbrance/Contract No. OCA-2020-00014074, Commodity 96207, Vendor VC20777.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
