WHEREAS, on September 23, 2020, City Council authorized the final reading and adoption of the appropriation ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2020-21 City of Dallas Operating, Capital, and Grant & Trust Budgets by Resolution No. 20-1484; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary for official action to be taken by the City Council to define services to be received and authorize payment of these funding allocations during Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a twelve-month funding agreement with Dallas County Audubon Society, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the Cedar Ridge Preserve to provide services and programs within the city of Dallas for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$56,002.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$56,002.00 to Dallas County Audubon Society from the General Fund, Fund 0001, Department PKR, Unit 5231, Object 3072, Encumbrance/Contract No. PKR-2020-000014793, Vendor 509534, as vouchers are processed by the Park & Recreation Department.

SECTION 3. That services to be provided are to: operate and maintain the Cedar Ridge Preserve, provide access for the public to 633 acres of escarpment and trails in Southwest Dallas, provide environmental education programs on the ecosystem and presentations at community centers and schools for 12 months.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
