WHEREAS, on September 9, 2015, City Council authorized a five-year service contract for pest control services at City facilities with Shamrock Pest Control, Inc. in the amount of \$734,924 and Pest Management of Texas, Inc. in the amount of \$75,000, in a total amount not to exceed \$809,924, by Resolution No. 15-1646.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Shamrock Pest Control, Inc. (VC14244) in the estimated amount of \$347,910 and Pest Management of Texas, Inc. (VS87473) in the estimated amount of \$1,500, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for integrated pest management services for citywide use at City facilities for a term of five years, in the total estimated amount of \$349,410. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Shamrock Pest Control, Inc. and Pest Management of Texas, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Shamrock Pest Control, Inc. and Pest Management of Texas, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$349,410, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Shamrock Pest Control, Inc. and Pest Management of Texas, Inc. from Service Price Agreement No. POM-2020-00012953.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
