WHEREAS, on January 22, 2020, City Council authorized a construction services contract with SYB Construction Company, Inc. for the installation of water and wastewater mains at six locations by Resolution No. 20-0221; and

WHEREAS, after award of the construction contract, storm drainage needs were identified at the intersection of Joyce Way and Douglas Avenue, and it was determined that drainage improvements should be included as part of the water and wastewater main improvements at Joyce Way; and

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary to authorize an increase in the construction services contract with SYB Construction Company, Inc., for drainage improvements at the intersection of Joyce Way and Douglas Avenue; and

**WHEREAS,** SYB Construction Company, Inc., 421 Compton Avenue, Irving, Texas 75061, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

WHEREAS, Dallas Water Utilities recommends that Contract No. 19-375/376 be increased by \$61,677.00, from \$4,293,456.25 to \$4,355,133.25.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That an increase in the construction services contract with SYB Construction Company, Inc. (Change Order No. 1) is authorized for drainage improvements at the intersection of Joyce Way and Douglas Avenue, in an amount not to exceed \$61,677.00, increasing the contract amount from \$4,293,456.25 to \$4,355,133.25.

**SECTION 2.** That the proposed Change Order No. 1 with SYB Construction Company, Inc. be accepted and that Contract No. 19-375/376 be revised accordingly.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$61,677.00 to SYB Construction Company, Inc. from the Storm Drainage Management Capital Construction Fund, Fund 0063, Department SDM, Unit W643, Object 4599, Program SD20W643, Encumbrance/Contract No. DWU-2020-00012100, Vendor 507202.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
