WHEREAS, on January 27, 2016, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for the removal and disposal of waste collected in sand traps, grease traps, interceptors and septic tanks with Stericycle Environmental Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$819,002.00 and Liquid Environmental Solutions of Texas, LLC in the amount of \$39,895.00, in a total amount not to exceed \$858,897.00, by Resolution No. 16-0161.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Earthtek, Inc. (VC22429), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for sand trap, grease trap, interceptors, and septic tank cleaning services for citywide use for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$798,055.87. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Earthtek, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Earthtek, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$798,055.87, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Earthtek, Inc. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. POM-2020-00014578.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
