WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice passed through the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD) has made funding available to the City of Dallas Division to have a centralized executive level meeting room where critical events and incidents can be effectively monitored; and

WHEREAS, grant monies are being allocated to the City of Dallas for the Critical Incident Command Center Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas designates the City Manager or an Assistant City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, that in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the City of Dallas will return all grant funds to the Office of the Governor, CJD, in full; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept the Critical Incident Command Center (CICC) Grant (Grant No. 4044001, Federal/State Award ID No. 2018-DJ-BX-0485, CFDA No.16.738) in the amount of \$100,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice through the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division to have a centralized executive level meeting room where critical events and incidents can be effectively monitored for the period October 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021; and execute the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the grant agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, in the Critical Incident Command Center Fund, Fund F659, Department DPD, Unit170C, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 into the Critical Incident Command Center Fund, Fund F659, Department DPD, Unit 170C, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 from the Critical Incident Command Center Fund, Fund F659, Department DPD, Unit 170C, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

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SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in the event of loss, or misuse of funds, in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of any return of grant funds not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all CJD final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2021-00015309.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
