WHEREAS, on August 23, 2017, City Council authorized a three-year service contract to monitor, maintain, and repair the tunnel lights and jet fans under Klyde Warren Park with CMC Network Solutions, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$6,006,685, by Resolution No. 17-1265.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with CMC Network Solutions, LLC (VC16003), approved as to form by the City Attorney, to monitor, maintain, and repair the Woodall-Rodgers Tunnel lights and jet fans for the Department of Transportation for a term of three years, with two one-year renewal options, in the estimated amount of \$5,025,916. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to CMC Network Solutions, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by CMC Network Solutions, LLC under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$5,025,916, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to CMC Network Solutions, LLC from Service Price Agreement Contract No. TRN-2020-00014307.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
