WHEREAS, on January 28, 2015, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for Microsoft premier support services with Microsoft Corporation through the Department of Information Resources, State of Texas Cooperative contract in an amount not exceed \$225,547, by Resolution No. 15-0155; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2018, Administrative Action No. 18-5395 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the service contract with Microsoft Corporation for the Microsoft premier support services to extend the service contract from February 27, 2018 to April 30, 2018, in an amount not to exceed \$9,105, from \$225,547 to \$234,652; and

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2018, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for Microsoft premier support services with Microsoft Corporation through the State of Texas Department of Information Resources cooperative agreement in an amount not to exceed \$328,987, by Resolution No. 18-0616.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Microsoft Corporation (266605) through the Department of Information Resources cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for Microsoft premier support services for the Department of Information and Technology Services, for a term of one year, in an amount not to exceed \$395,734. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments to Microsoft Corporation shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Microsoft Corporation under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$395,734 to Microsoft Corporation from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement No. DSV-2021-00015472.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
