WHEREAS, Dallas Animal Services' amended COVID-19 lifesaving operations and implementation of the social services-inspired Human Animal Support Systems (HASS) model, is expected to result in unplanned expenses towards supplies and temporary staffing; and

**WHEREAS,** it is now recommended that the City Manager be authorized to accept a grant from Maddie's Fund to be used for the purchase of supplies and funding for temporary staffing needed to best serve the community and maintain a 90 percent live release rate in a COVID-19 world.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 from Maddie's Fund to be used to fund temporary staff and supplies for innovative, HASS-model lifesaving programs, for the period of December 14, 2020 through July 1, 2021, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to be used to purchase pet food.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to \$50,000.00 in the Maddie's Fund HASS Pilot Shelter Fund, Fund PC08, Department DAS, Unit 905F, Revenue Code 8411.

**SECTION 3.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 in the Maddie's Fund HASS Pilot Shelter Fund, Fund PC08, Department DAS, Unit 905F, Objects 2280 and 3994.

**SECTION 4.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 in the Maddie's Fund HASS Pilot Shelter Fund, Fund PC08, Department DAS, Unit 905F, Objects 2280 and 3994.

**SECTION 5.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

**SECTION 6.** That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final Maddie's Fund monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

**SECTION 7.** That this contract is designated as Contract No. DAS-2021-00015508.

**SECTION 8.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
