**WHEREAS,** Dallas Animal Services has identified expenses related to the Empty the Shelter event sponsored by Bissell Pet Foundation; and

**WHEREAS,** it is now recommended that the City Manager be authorized to accept a grant from Bissell Pet Foundation Empty the Shelters in the amount of \$7,550.00 to be used for partial reimbursement for the adoption prep of each animal adopted during the COVID-19 virtual Empty the Shelters event for the period of December 9, 2020 through December 13, 2020

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from Bissell Pet Foundation Empty the Shelters in the amount of \$7,550.00 to be used for partial reimbursement for the adoption prep of each animal adopted during the COVID-19 virtual Empty the Shelters event for the period of December 9, 2020 through December 13, 2020, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$7,550.00 in the Bissell Pet Foundation December Empty the Shelters Grant Fund, Fund PC10, Department DAS, Unit 914G, Object 2280.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$7,550.00 in the Bissell Pet Foundation December Empty the Shelters Grant Fund, Fund PC10, Department DAS, Unit 914G, Revenue Code 8411.

**SECTION 4.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$7,550.00 from the Bissell Pet Foundation December Empty the Shelters Grant Fund, Fund PC10, Department DAS, Unit 914G, Object 2280, Encumbrance/Contract No. DAS-2021-00015469.

**SECTION 5.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

**SECTION 6.** That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final Bissell Pet Foundation monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

**SECTION 7.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
