WHEREAS, on January 8, 2020, City Council authorized the acceptance of a grant from the U.S. Departments of Commerce and Transportation through the State of Texas Commission on State Emergency Communications for the Federal 911 Grant Program (Grant No. 20C-0031-Dallas ECD/Federal ID No. 69N37619300000911 TX0, CFDA No. 20.615) to implement the Next Generation 9-1-1 System for the period from execution date through March 31, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$3,245,088.00, by Resolution No. 20-0130.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with AT&T Corporation (268653) through the Department of Information Resources cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purchase of hardware, software, and managed services to upgrade the City's 9-1-1 system for the Department of Information and Technology Services for a term of five-years, in an amount not to exceed \$9,960,327.12. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments to AT&T Corporation shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by AT&T Corporation under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$9,960,327.12 (subject to annual appropriations) to AT&T Corporation from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DSV-2020-00013631.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
