WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article X of the Dallas City Code establishes a Public Art Program to include works of art and design services of artists in certain City capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, in carrying out the intent of the Public Art Program, the Office of Arts and Culture, working with the Public Art Committee, has identified a public art project to be installed at Martyr's Park located at 379 Commerce Street; and

WHEREAS, Allbritton Lee LLC was selected for the project and was recommended by the Public Art Committee and the Arts and Culture Advisory Commission; and

WHEREAS, \$150,000.00 is available from the DWU Public Art Fund to support the fabrication and installation of a site-specific artwork at Martyr's Park located at 379 Commerce Street.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Allbritton Lee, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the fabrication and installation of a site-specific artwork at Martyr's Park located on 379 Commerce Street, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 from the DWU Public Art Fund, Fund 0121, Department DWU, Unit CW95, Object 4425, Program 7PUBART17, Encumbrance/Contract No. OCA-2021-00016048, Commodity 91200, Vendor VC21697.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
