WHEREAS, the City of Dallas owns water rights in Lewisville Lake including agricultural (irrigation) water rights; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hickory Creek requests to purchase untreated water from the City of Dallas for irrigating and maintaining landscaping and medians within town limits located along Lewisville Lake within Denton County;

WHEREAS, Dallas and Hickory Creek desire to enter into an Untreated Water Contract; and.

WHEREAS, the term of the new three-year contract with four three-year periods of renewal, not to exceed 15 years, with the Town of Hickory Creek to provide untreated water services, from June 27, 2021 through June 26, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, approval of the contract would be in the best interest of the City of Dallas as well as the Town of Hickory Creek.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a three-year Untreated Water Contract, with four three-year renewal options, an Untreated Water Contract with the Town of Hickory Creek, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to purchase untreated water services from the City of Dallas for the period June 27, 2021 through June 26, 2024, in the estimated annual amount of \$10.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to deposit receipts for service provided under this contract to the Dallas Water Utilities Fund, Fund 0100, Department DWU, Unit 7005, Object 7REV, Revenue Code 7849.

SECTION 3. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DWU-2021-00016277.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
