WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality offered grant awards for the construction of alternative fueling facilities through the Alternative Fueling Facilities Program; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enhance its resiliency and use of compressed natural gas as a more environmentally friendly option for fueling its vehicles and equipment.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) through the Alternative Fueling Facilities Program (AFFP) (Contract No. 582-21-22682-AF) to construct a compressed natural gas (CNG) facility at 9811 Harry Hines Boulevard to allow fast fill CNG fueling for City vehicles and equipment in the amount of \$400,000.00 for the period June 23, 2021 through April 30, 2023; execution of the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the grant agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 in the CNG AFFP Program Fund, Fund S366, Department EFM, Unit 102E, Revenue Code 6516.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 in the CNG AFFP Program Fund, Fund S366, Department EFM, Unit 102E, Object 4599, Program EFM AFFP.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 from the CNG AFFP Program Fund, Fund S366, Department EFM, Unit 102E, Object 4599, Program EFM AFFP, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-EFM-2021-00016576.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final TCEQ monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to provide additional information, make adjustments, and take other actions related to the implementation of the grant as may be necessary to satisfy TCEQ.

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SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
