WHEREAS, on March 25, 2020, City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for industrial, medical, and welding gases with Air Gas USA LLC in the estimated amount of \$902,819.62, by Resolution No. 20-0480.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That a master agreement for the purchase of industrial, medical, and welding gases is authorized with Airgas USA LLC. (VS88116) in the estimated amount of \$114,234.44 and The Habits Group, LLC (VC23084) in the estimate amount of \$13,500.00, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of three years in a total estimated amount of \$127,734.44. The amount payable pursuant to this master agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the contract for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for industrial, medical, and welding gases. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases of industrial, medical, and welding gases under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is authorized to execute the contract upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$127,734.44, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term to Airgas USA LLC. and The Habits Group, LLC from Master Agreement Contract No. POM-2020-00013101.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
