WHEREAS, on December 11, 2019, City Council authorized a construction contract with DDM Construction Corporation, for the construction of street paving, storm drainage improvements, and water and wastewater improvements for Street Reconstruction Group 17-6001, in an amount of \$4,181,920.70, by Resolution No. 19-1624; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2021, City Council authorized Change Order No. 1 to the construction services contract with DDM Construction Corporation to allow for additional removal of concrete subgrade for Street Reconstruction Group 17-6001, in the amount of \$390,996.63, increasing the contract amount from \$4,181,920.70 to \$4,572,917.33, by Resolution No. 21-0602; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize Change Order No. 2 to the construction services contract with DDM Construction Corporation to allow additional work for Dallas Water Utilities to resolve a conflict with the proposed storm water line associated with Street Reconstruction Group 17-6001, in an amount not to exceed \$80,292.50, increasing the contract amount from \$4,572,917.33 to \$4,653,209.83.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase to the construction services contract with DDM Construction Corporation (Change Order No. 2) is authorized to allow additional work for Dallas Water Utilities to resolve a conflict with the proposed storm water line associated with Street Reconstruction Group 17-6001, in an amount not to exceed \$80,292.50, increasing the contract amount from \$4,572,917.33 to \$4,653,209.83.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$80,292.50 for DDM Construction Corporation, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract from the Wastewater Capital Improvement E Fund, Fund 3116, Department DWU, Unit PS42, Object 4560 Program 719588, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-PBW-2019-00011514, Vendor VS97675.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
