BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Carbon Silica Services, LLC dba Diamond Services (VS94198), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the inspection and repair of existing fiberglass-reinforced plastic chemical storage tanks for the Water Utilities Department for a term of one year, in an amount not to exceed \$1,102,866. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to Carbon Silica Services, LLC dba Diamond Services shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Carbon Silica Services, LLC dba Diamond Services under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,102,866 to Carbon Silica Services, LLC dba Diamond Services from Service Contract No. DWU-2021-00017080.

SECTION 3. That the purchase of new chlorine process equipment for the Water Utilities Department is authorized with DPC Industries, Inc. (VS0000000862), in an amount not to exceed \$214,575.

SECTION 4. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate requisition, to issue a purchase order for new chlorine process equipment for the Water Utilities Department. If a formal contract is required for this purchase instead of a purchase order, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$214,575 to DPC Industries, Inc., as follows:

Water Construction Fund

Fund 0102, Department DWU, Unit CW50, Object 4730, Service Contract No. DWU-2021-00017080, Amount 160,000

Dallas Water Utilities Fund

Fund 0100, Department DWU, Unit 7270, Object 2120, Service Contract No. DWU-2021-00017080, Amount \$54,575

Total amount not to exceed \$214,575

SECTION 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
