**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City to improve the efficiency of our municipal operations by adopting an annual City Calendar; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual City Calendar should be presented to the City Council for adoption in October of each year for the upcoming calendar year; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual City Calendar should include all City Council briefing and agenda meetings, budget briefings and workshops, City Council Committee meetings, and City holidays; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Calendar should be updated periodically to incorporate any additions and/or changes in the schedule of meetings; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Calendar should be made available to all residents, upon request, in the Mayor and City Council Office.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Dallas City Council amends Resolution No. 20-1728, previously approved on October 28, 2020, to authorize an amendment to the 2021 City Calendar to **(1)** include October 11, 2021 as a City Holiday in recognition of Indigenous Peoples' Day/Columbus Day; **(2)** move the Workforce, Education and Equity Committee and the Public Safety Committee to Tuesday, October 12, 2021; and **(3)** include November 11, 2021 as a City Holiday in recognition of Veterans Day.

**SECTION 2.** That the Dallas City Council adopts the amended 2021 City Calendar per Attachment A.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
