WHEREAS, on December 13, 2017, City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for the purchase of anhydrous ammonia for Dallas Water Utilities with Shrieve Chemical Company, in an amount not to exceed \$1,717,200.00, by Resolution No. 17-1877; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2018, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for tank evacuation, cleaning, and inspection services for the Water Utilities Department with Action Environmental, LLC dba Team Action, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$196,690.44, by Resolution No. 18-0085.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Shrieve Chemical Company (VC17161), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purchase of bulk anhydrous ammonia and ammonia tank evacuation, cleaning, and inspection services for the Water Utilities Department for a term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$1,707,925.00. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Shrieve Chemical Company shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Shrieve Chemical Company under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$1,707,925, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Shrieve Chemical Company from Service Price Agreement Contract No. DWU-2021-00017261.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
