**BACKGROUND**

On October 26, 2022, a proposal was received for the Willie Mae Butler Playground Renovation for the installation of playground equipment and replacement of a curb ramp. Whirlix Design, LLC a Texas Association of School Boards (BuyBoard) vendor, provided a bid proposal in the amount of \$135,565.52 for the installation of playground equipment and replacement of a curb ramp.
