**SUBJECT**

A resolution authorizing a joint elections agreement and election services contract between the City of Dallas, Denton County, and various other jurisdictions within Denton County, for the conduct of a special election to be held Saturday, May 4, 2024 - Not to exceed \$17,000.00 - Financing: General Fund

**BACKGROUND**

Subchapter D of Chapter 31 of the Texas Election Code provides that the City may contract with the county elections administrator for certain election services. Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code provides that the City may enter into an agreement with other political jurisdictions that may be conducting elections on the same day in election precincts that can be served by common polling places.

The City of Dallas and other political jurisdictions in Denton County will conduct elections on Saturday, May 4, 2024. This action authorizes the City to hold the May 4, 2024 special election

jointly with jurisdictions that share common polling places and contract with the Denton County Elections Department for election services. The City has been a party to similar joint election agreements for many years.
