BACKGROUND

This item grants a private license to DCPG I, Inc. for the use of approximately 1,143 square feet of land to occupy, maintain and utilize a subsurface electrical vault meter under a portion of Wood Street right-of-way located near its intersection with Market Street. The use of this area will not impede pedestrian or vehicular traffic. The term of this license is forty years.

The licensee will indemnify the City and carry general liability insurance naming the City as an additional insured.
