### SUBJECT

Authorize a construction services contract for the construction of Street and Alley Petition and Target Neighborhood Group 17-1302 (list attached to the Agenda Information Sheet) - Jeske Construction Company, lowest responsible bidder of four - Not to exceed \$3,379,173.00 - Financing: 2024B Certificate of Obligation Fund (\$2,320,430.00), Wastewater Capital Improvement F Fund (\$378,288.00), Water Capital Improvement G Fund (\$644,865.00), Wastewater Construction Fund (\$23,990.00), and Water Construction Fund (\$11,600.00)

### BACKGROUND

This action will authorize a construction services contract with Jeske Construction Company for the construction of one street, three alley petition, and two target neighborhood projects as Street and Alley Petition and Target Neighborhood Group 17-1302.

The scope of this project group includes replacing the existing deteriorating streets and alleys with

reinforced concrete pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk, driveway approaches, storm drainage, water and wastewater improvements, and other miscellaneous items necessary to complete the work in accordance with plans and specifications.
