BACKGROUND

Big D Cut Rate Beer and Wine is located at 1405 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, Dallas Texas. Big D Cut Rate Beer and Wine operates under a certificate of occupancy for a beer and wine retail use. The property at 1405 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard is zoned a WMU-3 Walkable Urban Mixed Use Subdistrict within Planned Development District No. 595 (South Dallas/Fair Park Special Purpose District). A beer and wine retail use is not a permitted use in a WMU-3 Walkable Urban Mixed Use Subdistrict. Big D Cut Rate Beer and Wine is operating as a nonconforming use because the use was established prior to the creation of PD 595. Section 51A-4.704(a)(1) allows City Council to request that the Board of Adjustment consider establishing a compliance date for a nonconforming

use.
