Title: Authorize the (1) first amendment to the grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency passed through the Texas Office of the Governor-Homeland Security Grants Division for the FY 2022 Homeland Security Grant, which includes the Urban Area Security Initiative (Federal/State Award ID No. EMW-2022-SS-00021/Grant Nos. 4354602, 3698805, 3418206, 3929604, 2980708, 2980308, 3176407, 4575501, and 4576701, Assistance Listing No. 97.067) to accept additional grant funds in the amount of \$156,246.26, from \$6,547,275.00 to \$6,703,521.26 to provide funding for activities related to enhancing preparedness and building capacity to prepare for, prevent and respond to complex coordinated terrorist attacks for the period January 1, 2023 through February 28, 2025; (2) increase in appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$156,246.26 in the 2022 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative 23-25 Fund; (3) receipt and deposit of grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$156,246.26 in the 2022 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative 23-25 Fund; and (4) execution of the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement - Not to exceed \$156,246.26, from \$6,547,275.00 to \$6,703,521.26 - Financing: U.S. Department of Homeland Security Grant Funds
