Authorize partial settlement of the consolidated lawsuit styled Ahmed Ahmed v. City of Dallas v. Ahmed Ahmed and Brinks Incorporated consolidated with Jose Penas v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-22-00009 - Not to exceed \$150,000.00 for the settlement of Ahmed Ahmed’s claims and \$30,000.00 for the settlement of Jose Penas’s claims - Financing: Liability Reserve Fund

BACKGROUND

Plaintiffs Ahmed Ahmed and Jose Penas each filed a lawsuit against the City of Dallas seeking compensation for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile collision on March 24, 2020, involving a city-owned sanitation truck. The individual lawsuits were later consolidated under the above-styled cause of action. The City and Plaintiffs have reached proposed settlements, subject to City Council approval. Plaintiff Ahmed Ahmed is represented by Daniella Alvarado and Link & Associates. Plaintiff Jose Penas is represented by Glenn D. Tucker, Sr. and the Law Offices of Glenn D. Tucker, Sr.
