SUBJECT

Authorize a construction services contract for the construction of Alley Reconstruction Group 17-8003 (list attached to the Agenda Information Sheet) - Jeske Construction Co., lowest responsible bidder of three - Not to exceed \$1,792,675.00 - Financing: Street and Transportation (A) Fund (2017 General Obligation Bond Fund)

BACKGROUND

This action will authorize a construction services contract with Jeske Construction Co. for the construction of three alley reconstruction projects as Alley Reconstruction Group 17-8003.

The scope of the project will include replacing the existing deteriorating alleys with reinforced concrete pavement, driveway approaches, storm drainage system, and other miscellaneous items needed to complete the project, in accordance with the plans and specifications.
