BACKGROUND

The North Central Council of Governments (NCTCOG) receives grant funding from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to administer the Solid Waste Program in the 16-county North

Central Texas region. These funds are generated by landfill tipping fees to the 24 Councils of Government located in the state of Texas.

NCTCOG has awarded the maximum funding requested for its Solid Waste Implementation Grant of \$200,000.00 to the Dallas Park and Recreation Department Treecycling Project. The project includes the purchase of one piece of equipment, a trommel, that would allow the Dallas Park and Recreation Department to divert approximately 1,000 tons of chipped tree material from the municipal landfill annually and to filter chips to be used for mulching at park properties.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS)

On December 12, 2019, the Park and Recreation Board authorized an application for a Solid Waste Implementation Grant in the amount of \$200,000.00 from the North Central Texas Council of Governments for the Dallas Park and Recreation Department Treecycling Project.

On January 22, 2020, City Council authorized an application for a Solid Waste Implementation Grant in the amount of \$200,000.00 from the North Central Texas Council of Governments for the Dallas Park and Recreation Department Treecycling Project by Resolution No. 20-0218.

On August 20, 2020, the Park and Recreation Board authorized acceptance of a Solid Waste Implementation Grant in the amount of \$200,000.00 from the North Central Texas Council of Governments for the Dallas Park and Recreation Department Treecycling Project for Fiscal Year 2020-21.
