BACKGROUND

This item authorizes the acquisition from Lester J. Lawson and Celeste L. Lawson, of approximately 2,896 square feet of land located in Dallas County. This property will be used for the construction of the Southwest 120/96-inch Water Transmission Pipeline Project. The consideration is based on an independent appraisal. There are no relocation benefits associated.

This acquisition is part of the Long Range Water Master Plan and the Water Distribution Master Plan. The water transmission main is required to facilitate conveyance of treated water to the South and Southwest portions of Dallas and its customer cities. Installation of approximately 32 miles of 96-inch

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and 120-inch water transmission pipeline is needed to meet near term critical demands associated with the population growth as determined through master planning efforts. The overall pipeline is sized to meet future water demands.
