This item authorizes the conveyance of a water easement, access easement and two temporary construction easements containing a total of approximately 20 acres of land to North Texas Municipal Water District ("District") for the construction, maintenance and use of pipeline facilities over and across City-owned land located at Lake Ray Hubbard. The easements are needed for a new 48-inch water line that will convey water from the District's Wylie Water Treatment Plant to serve growing demand in the east portion of the District's water system.
