SUBJECT

Authorize Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to exercise the first of two, two-year renewal options to the service contract with Convergent Technologies, LLC to provide maintenance and support for the existing airport access control system for the Department of Aviation - Not to exceed \$1,244,482 - Financing: Aviation Fund (subject to annual appropriations)

BACKGROUND

This action does not encumber funds; the purpose of a service contract is to establish firm pricing for services, for a specific term, which are ordered on an as needed basis.

This Supplemental Agreement will provide for continued maintenance and support for the existing airport access control system (AACS) for the Department of Aviation. The AACS includes closed circuit television subsystem, security intercom subsystem, video badging/credentialing subsystem (including physical identity and access management, and fingerprint processing components), AACS controlled doors and door hardware, and other components at the Dallas Airport Facilities. This contract also serves as the basis for implementing any future modifications to the existing AACS

undertaken throughout the term of this agreement.

On November 10, 2015, City Council authorized a living wage policy that requires contractors to pay their employees a “living wage” rate as established annually by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Living Wage Calculator for Dallas County by Resolution No. 15-2141. This contract renewal option includes the most current living wage of 12.38.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)

On September 14, 2016, City Council authorized a five-year service contract, with two two-year renewal options, to provide maintenance and support for the existing airport access control system at Dallas Love Field with Convergent Technologies, LLC by Resolution 16-1427.
