BACKGROUND

This action will authorize a construction contract with Roadway Solutions, Inc., lowest responsible bidder of three, to construct five traffic signals as part of services for the Warranted Traffic Signal Installations—Group 9 Project.

Bid specifications were developed and publicly advertised on June 9, 2021, and June 16, 2021, for

competitive bids associated with the Warranted Traffic Signal Installations - Group 9 Project. Bids were opened on July 16, 2021.
