BACKGROUND

On June 23, 2021, the City Council authorized two-year contracts, with two five-year renewal options,

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for property management, supportive services, and renovations for temporary and permanent housing for the Office of Homeless Solutions with CitySquare in the amount of \$3,291,666.00 and Family Gateway, Inc. in the amount of \$2,911,856.00, for a total amount of \$6,203,522.00.
