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Title: December 14, 2022, City Council Agenda #65; 22-2612 Authorize the (1) application for and acceptance of the State of Texas Internet Crimes Against Children Grant (Grant No. 2745109) from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division in the amount of \$322,510.00 to provide for one-year funding for the salaries and fringe benefits of two detectives and one police research specialist, to fund training, direct operating expenses and use of overtime to address the growing problem of technology-facilitated child abuse and exploitation for the period September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2023; (2) establishment of appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$322,510.00 in the State Internet Crimes Against Children Grant FY23 Fund; (3) receipt and deposit of grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$322,510.00 in the State Internet Crimes Against Children Grant FY23 Fund; and (4) execution of the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the grant agreement with the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division - Not to exceed \$322,510.00 - Financing: Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division State Grant Funds [Jon Fortune, Deputy City Manager, City Manager's Office]
