BACKGROUND

The 2021 Recommended Regional Amendments were approved for distribution by the North Central Texas Council Of Governments Executive Board at their July 22, 2021 and October 28, 2021

meetings.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)

On December 13, 2022, the Building Inspection Advisory, Examining and Appeals Board reviewed and recommended adoption of the 2021 International Mechanical Code.
