### SUBJECT

A resolution amending Section 5 of the City Council Rules of Procedure for electing the mayor pro tem and deputy mayor pro tem for one-year terms and codifying the ballot process - Financing: No cost consideration to the City

### BACKGROUND

The proposed resolution reflects the recommendation of the Ad Hoc Committee on Administrative Affairs to amend the City Council Rules of Procedure to codify the election process for the mayor pro tem and deputy mayor pro tem. The amendment provides that the election shall be conducted by ballot at a regular or special-called meeting of the city council and that the mayor pro tem and deputy mayor pro tem are elected to one-year terms.
