<u>SUBJECT</u>

Authorize a construction contract for the Hall of State Restoration Project located at 3939 Grand Avenue in Fair Park - Phoenix I Restoration and Construction, Ltd., best value proposer of four - Not to exceed \$8,754,600.00 - Financing: Fair Park Improvements (C) Fund (2017 Bond Funds)

BACKGROUND

On July 12, 2019, four proposals were received for the Hall of State Restoration Project.

This action will authorize the award of a construction contract with Phoenix I Restoration and Construction, Ltd. for Base Price and Alternate Nos. 1 - 17 for a total contract amount of \$8,754,600.00.

A construction contract with Horsley Specialties, Inc. for the removal of lead-based paint, visible mold growth and asbestos-containing materials at the Hall of State will be considered by separate action on September 11, 2019.
