SUBJECT

Authorize the first of two, one-year renewal options to the contract with METCO Engineering, Inc. through a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with Dallas County, to provide job order contracting services for facility projects through November 7, 2020 - Not to exceed \$2,000,000.00, from \$4,000,000.00 to \$6,000,000.00 - Financing: Park and Recreation Facilities (B) Fund (2017 Bond Funds) (subject to appropriations)

BACKGROUND

On June 27, 2018, City Council authorized a sixteen-month contract, with two one-year renewal options, with METCO Engineering, Inc., through a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with Dallas County, to provide job order contracting services for facility projects through November 7, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000.00, by Resolution No. 18-0995.

This action will authorize the first of two, one-year renewal options to the contract with METCO Engineering, Inc. through a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with Dallas County, to provide job order contracting services for facility projects through November 7, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00, increasing the contract amount from \$4,000,000.00 to \$6,000,000.00. Projects will be funded on an as-needed basis, up to this limit.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)

On June 7, 2018, the Park and Recreation Board authorized a contract with METCO Engineering, Inc.
