## <u>SUBJECT</u>

Authorize (1) an Emergency Home Repair Program (Program) - as described in **Exhibit A** in response to the 2021 Texas Severe Winter Storm to provide a grant of up to \$10,000.00 per household for emergency repairs for low- to moderate-income persons at or below 80 percent of the area median income; (2) execution of all documents and agreements necessary to implement the Program, including but not limited to agreements with homeowners, contractors, and/or administration agreement(s) for the Program and change orders/amendments; (3) a one-time transfer of funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Public Private Partnership Fund to the Emergency Home Repair Program Fund; (4) an increase in appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Emergency Home Repair Program Fund; (5) a disbursement of funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Emergency Home Repair Program Fund; (5) a disbursement of funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Emergency Home Repair Program Fund; (6) an increase in appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Emergency Home Repair Program Fund in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Emergency Home Repair Program Fund in accordance with the Program; and (6) up to 10 percent of the funds to be utilized for program administration - Not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 - Financing: Emergency Home Repair Program Fund

## BACKGROUND

On, February 14, 2021, a Texas Disaster Declaration for the Texas Severe Winter Storm (EM-3554-TX) was put into effect.

The Department of Housing and Neighborhood Revitalization (Housing) has identified an emergency need for home repairs related to the 2021 Texas Severe Winter Storm, an activity to provide assistance to low- to moderate-income persons at or below 80 percent of the area median income (AMI). The Program will provide a grant of up to \$10,000.00 for emergency repairs to homes. Housing will follow the emergency procurement process to accept a minimum of three bids from nonprofits to partner with administration of the Program.

This action will authorize the establishment of the Program as described in **Exhibit A** due to the 2021 Texas Severe Winter Storm to provide a grant of up to \$10,000.00 per household for emergency repairs for low- and moderate-income persons at or below 80 percent of the AMI to make repairs to homes and the execution of all documents and agreements necessary to implement the Program.
