WHEREAS, on March 7, 2025, Administrative Action No. 25-5490 authorized a one-year service contract to provide independent medical examination, peer review, and bill review services, including, but not limited to, reviewing documents and advising the City in matters concerning the evaluation of medical and health-related claims for accuracy and legitimacy with North American Consultants, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with North American Consultants, Inc. (VC33274), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for comprehensive medical review and personal injury analysis services for the City Attorney's Office and the Office of Risk Management for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$1,598,040. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to North American Consultants, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by North American Consultants, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$1,598,040 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to North American Consultants, Inc. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. ATT-2026-00029387.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
